This packed tour of Central Europe focuses on Hungary and the Czech Republic with the opportunity to visit the respective capitals of Budapest and Prague. In addition, we spend time on Lake Balaton in Hungary and around the towns of Ceske Budejovice and Brno in The Czech Republic. Our route takes us through France and Germany into Austria where we will visit the capital, Vienna. Our route back allows a brief visit to Slovakia, with the chance to visit the capital Bratislava. This is an exciting and adventurous tour, which provides a real flavour of the richness and diversity of Central Europe along with five capital cities as we take in Luxembourg City on the return leg.

WHO IS THE TOUR FOR:

- Adventurous motorhomers who want to explore Central Europe focussing on Hungary and the Czech Republic with the chance to visit Prague, Budapest, Vienna and Bratislava.

- Price is £2500 for up to two people travelling in their own motorhome if booked before 31/12/18 and £2600 thereafter. Supplement of £500 for each additional person.
- Existing customers get a Loyalty Bonus of £50. This will be shown as a discount on your final invoice.
- Payment of the deposit secures your place on the tour with final payment due ten weeks before departure. **The deposit is non-refundable.**

DAY BY DAY

NIGHT BEFORE: We stay on a campsite close to Dover where we provide a full briefing for the tour and advice on motorhoming on the continent in general. This is a complimentary night and you are welcome to join us at no additional cost.

DAYS 1 - 2: Over the next two days, we travel deep into France with overnight stops in the Champagne and Alsace regions.

DAYS 3: We head into Bavaria in Germany with our overnight stop on the Romantic Road.

DAYS 4 - 5: We head north east via Austria to our first destination in the Czech Republic, close to the historic towns of Ceske Budejovice and Ceske Krumlov. Both have beautifully preserved old towns and the former is home to the Budvar brewery.

DAYS 6 - 9: We head back into Austria today close to the capital Vienna. Visually stunning, Vienna is home to many fine buildings, churches, palaces and museums and has a packed cultural calendar. Slovakia's capital, Bratislava is just an hour away by train, which makes for a fascinating day trip.

DAYS 10 - 11: The tour now enters Hungary for the first time, with Lake Balaton as our destination. At 230 square miles, it is the largest freshwater lake in Central Europe and its shores are home to many interesting resort towns. Our schedule allows two days to explore the area, which is perhaps best done by road.

DAY 12 - 15: We take a relatively short drive today to Hungary's capital, Budapest where our schedule allows for three full days in the city. Straddling the Danube, many of the city's most beautiful sites are located on either bank of the river.

DAYS 16 - 17: We head through Slovakia today with the chance to stop off in the capital Bratislava, or at the smaller walled town of Trnava. Our destination for the next two nights is the Czech Republic's second largest city, Brno.

DAYS 18 - 20: Today we head for our campsite close to the Czech capital, Prague. The city is perhaps one of Europe's finest destinations packed with history, art and architecture.

DAY 21: Today we start to head west as we head into Germany. Our overnight stop is close to Nuremburg with its distinctive Medieval architecture and fortifications.

DAY 22: Our relatively leisurely drive through Germany continues with a an overnight stop close to the Rhine.

DAY 23: We follow the path of the Mosel River with our destination being Luxembourg City. Our schedule allows of an afternoon and evening in the city, which is easily accessible from our campsite.

DAY 24: Today we head back into France to our final stopover in the Champagne region.

DAY 25: We head for Calais and our scheduled afternoon crossing, or you may choose to extend your stay and take advantage of your flexible return ticket.
